- → Trailer Driver (experience needed, understanding of liability)






Fundraising

Bingo




 \rightarrow biggest fundraiser

- \rightarrow approx. \$50K each year
- \rightarrow Hunter co-ordinates this effort
- \rightarrow needs a team of 10 volunteers
- \rightarrow training provided (30-45 min session)
- \rightarrow must be 18 years or older
- $ightarrow \,$ 2 time slots a month with 2 volunteers
- \rightarrow time and date assignments
